Caucasus and Byzantium Teaching FELLOWSHIPS Academic year 2010-11

The Center for Eastern Mediterranean Studies (CEMS) at the Central European University (CEU), Budapest, Hungary invites applications for a Teaching Fellowship at the Ivane Javakhishvili Tbilisi State University, Georgia.

ELIGIBILITY

The program targets CEU doctoral students who at the time of their trip to Georgia will have defended their prospectus and who have a research focus on Caucasian, Late Antique, Byzantine, Ottoman, or Medieval Studies.

Working language: English.

DURATION OF THE FELLOWSHIP: any two consecutive weeks during 15 April-31 May 2011.

LOCATION: Tbilisi, Georgia.

THE FELLOWSHIP CONSISTS OF: a stipend of 350 USD, free hotel accommodation, cost of visa and health insurance, travel reimbursement to and from Tbilisi, Georgia.

The Fellows are expected to teach a course of their choice (6 to 8 classes) to undergraduates and graduates (MA level) and to use this occasion for networking with their peers and scholars at the host university.

At the end of their Fellowship, each Fellow is expected to hand in a report, reflecting the results of his/her work over the duration of the Fellowship.

HOW TO APPLY

Applications will be submitted in electronic format only, to the address: cems@ceu.hu. Candidates are asked to enter in the *Subject* field of their e-mail message: "CEMS Caucasus and Byzantium Fellowship".

Please attach all relevant supporting materials to your application, e.g.:

- an outline of the course you will be teaching there: introduction, topics, outcomes;
- a short letter of purpose stating how and why will your stay in Georgia enrich your current research and future career;
- a short letter of recommendation from your supervisor (in a closed envelope or via e-mail to cems@ceu.hu).

The deadline for the submission of applications is March 15, 2011. The applicants will be notified on the results by 20 March, by e-mail.
